

## What the Cardinal's Appeal funds

**Special Ministries:** Support for a variety of social ministries with Black and Hispanic Catholics, young adults and the disabled


**Family and Pro-Life:** Support for family life ministries, birthing and care programs, natural family planning, pregnancy aid centers, and other pro-life activities

# Seminarians, Clergy, Chaplains

Chaplains serve daily at more than two dozen hospitals throughout the Archdiocese. They visit the sick and dying, bringing comfort and consolation of the sacraments to those in perhaps the most vulnerable and difficult moments of their lives.



The seminary provides the opportunity for young men in priestly formation to answer the call to encounter the Lord and his people through study, prayer, sacraments and apostolic ministry.

One young priest said, "I've thought about the priesthood since I was six or seven years old. I didn't know what it all meant back then, but the idea stayed with me. I am personally grateful for any support that the faithful can provide – whether financial or through prayer – for us seminarians to persevere."





### Education

Choosing Catholic Education means a child will receive a high-quality education with daily exposure to the moral and spiritual values of our faith. Many parents make great sacrifices to have this choice, and it is our commitment as the Archdiocese to stand with them. Support from the Cardinal's Appeal supplements tuition, strengthens inner city schools and provides the means to train religious educators and support parish religious education programs.

# Pro-Life Outreach Programs

Since 1991, the Birthing and Care Center Program and other similar initiatives have provided medical, financial, emotional and spiritual help to thousands of uninsured pregnant

women in the Archdiocese. Some women come to the Center in financial



crisis; some come with high-risk pregnancies; and some come on the verge of having an abortion. The Appeal supports several prolife efforts by working closely with other diocesan organizations for referrals and outreach in the surrounding Hispanic and African American communities. Further, the Cardinal's Appeal will help the

Center field hundreds of calls for help and shepherd nearly 200 women through their pregnancies.

# Special Ministries

The Spanish Catholic Center in Gaithersburg, Maryland, is a hub of activity for families seeking legal immigration counsel, job opportunities, English classes and health coverage for their children. Through the Job Lease program, area employers send representatives to match people with available positions. The Cardinal's Appeal empowers the center's hardworking staff to bring the hope and the love of Christ to families in need. At the Joseph P. Kennedy Institute, the Community Companions program provides parents who are caring for special needs children with precious moments of downtime.

Having a caring place where children can go after school gives parents a much-needed respite and offers the children additional time to socialize and have fun. Appeal donations help fund such things as summer camp, transportation vehicles, and food to help these young people enjoy being kids.






### Communications and Outreach

Since 1952, the Archdiocese of Washington has produced a televised Sunday Mass to those who are homebound, reaching more than 6,500 viewers on average across the Washington area each week. It is a vital ministry for those members of our Catholic family who are unable to be physically present with a local worshiping community for the Sunday Eucharistic Liturgy. Priests from around the Archdiocese faithfully share the opportunity to participate and serve as celebrants, joined by deacons and choirs from local parishes and schools. Support from the Cardinal's Appeal enables the Archdiocese to use television and other contemporary media to carry a message of caring to people who are isolated and looking for connection with their faith.







### Catholic Charities

Catholic Charities assists individuals and families in need, especially those who are most vulnerable. They focus on helping people develop the skills and strength to move from crisis or isolation to stability and growth.



They remain committed to the poor,

especially the homeless, immigrant newcomers at-risk and persons with mental and developmental disabilities.



Further, they pride their work on being accessible to those in need through comprehensive, integrated and culturally competent services. We strengthen Catholic Charities through partnerships with other providers, foundations, businesses, individuals, schools, and most especially the faithful throughout our Catholic parishes.
